- "2.6 The prohibition imposed by this Notification on export of non-basmati rice shall not be applicable to export of 50,000 MT of rice to Peoples Republic of Bangladesh by M/s LMJ International Limited, 30, J.L. Nehru Road, Kolkata $-700\,016$ against the said ordered quantity as per international tender opened by Government of Bangladesh on 08.10.2007."
