Export quota

On 21 April 2020, Vietnam through Notification 163/TB-VPCP notified that it will allow export of 100,000 tons of rice in the month of April 2020. This is in addition to the export of 400,000 tonnes announced for that month (see related State Act).

Vietnam had banned the exports of rice temporarily since 24 March 2020 before lifting it on 10 April 2020. The extra 100,000 tonnes allowed under the current notification relate to the rice that was transported to the ports prior to the export ban on 24 March.
