▲ Export ban

Vietnam has temporarily suspended rice exports from 25 March 2020 until the end of May 2020. The measure has been taken for the government to assess the domestic supplies during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The export ban has been lifted effective 11 April 2020 and an export quota of 400,000 tonnes for April 2020 has been introduced (see related State Act.)
