▲ Export tax

On 16 December 2019, the Egyptian Ministry of Trade and Industry issued Decree no. 1146 decreasing the export duty on some feeding ingredients for one year whilst extending it on some others until 31 December 2020.

The new Decree has decreased the export duty on straws and husks (HS 1213) from 900 EGP (56.11 USD) to 600 EGP (37.41 USD) until 31 December 2020. It has also divided the tariff line for vegetable waste (HS 2308) into two categories:

- Vegetable materials and vegetable waste, vegetable residues and by-products, of a kind used in animal feeding, except for corn and its firewood, which witnesses an extension of the pre-imposed export duty on 23 December 2018 until 31 December 2020, see related state act.
- Corn Silage, which witnesses a decrease in the export duty from 900 EGP (56.11 USD) to 300 EGP (18.70 USD) until 31 December 2020.

There had also been an extension for the export duty on alfalfa and feeding products (HS 1214) and barns (HS 2302) with the same rate until 31 December 2020, see related state act.

Update:

On 16 December 2020, the Ministry of Trade and Industry issued decree no. 625 of 2020 that extends the imposition of export duty on feeding ingredients specified in decree no. 1146 of 2019 until 31 December 2021.
