

Confirmation of Cairo 24.. Egypt lifts the ban on exporting wheat, beans, lentils and pasta | doc





The Customs Authority allowed the export **of basic commodities** once again, for which a decision was issued at the beginning of the year to ban their export, in order to preserve the needs of the local market, after a notification from the Ministry of .Industry and Foreign Trade to the Authority

Lifting the ban on exporting wheat, beans and lentils

According to a document that Cairo 24 obtained a copy of, the Customs Authority decided to stop implementing the decisions banning the export of a number of commodities, which include wheat, beans, lentils, pasta, flour, corn, oils, and freekeh, based on a notification from Ahmed Al-Askelani, Undersecretary of the Ministry of Industry. And Trade, Head of the Central Administration for Export and .Import Affairs

In his letter to Dr. Najwa Zaghmour, Head of the Central Administration for Customs Policies and Procedures, Al-Askelani mentioned that the decision on the last export .ban expired on September 7

The Undersecretary of the Ministry of Industry and Trade added that many inquiries had been received from some customs outlets regarding the issuance of a new ministerial decision to continue working with the aforementioned ministerial decisions or not. To date, no ministerial decisions have been issued to extend the .work of the aforementioned ministerial decisions

In this regard, the Customs Authority issued Export Circular No. 24 of 2022, applying what was stated in the letter of the Ministry of Industry and Foreign Trade regarding .not extending the work of the aforementioned ministerial decisions

Pebbled and crushed beans are not allowed to be exported

And Resolution No. 141 of 2022 stipulates not allowing the export of gravel and crushed beans, lentils, pasta, wheat and flour of all kinds, and Resolution No. 142 of 2022 regarding not allowing the export of edible oils of all kinds, freekeh and corn, while allowing the export of quantities in excess of the local market's needs of the incoming items. By ministerial decisions, which were estimated by the Ministry of Industry and Internal Trade, and after the approval of the Minister of Trade and .Industry, for a period of 3 months, which is the decision whose term has expired
