

# Egypt: Government bans export of wheat and other staples for 3 months

In March 2022, the Ministry of Trade and Industry announced the suspension of the export of wheat, fava beans, lentils, pasta and all kinds of flour for 3 months.

#### Export ban

On 10 March 2022, the Ministry of Trade and Industry of Egypt adopted Decree 141 for the year 2022 imposing a temporary export ban on wheat, fava beans, lentils, pasta, and all kinds of flour. The new measure applies for three months commencing on 11 March 2022.

According to Ahram Online, a government-owned newspaper, the action was adopted to preserve the local strategic reserves of these commodities, as local and international market prices are increasing due to the Russian invasion of Ukraine.
