S.O.(E) In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 5 read with Section 3(2) of the Foreign Trade (Development & Regulation) Act, 1992 (No.22 of 1992) and also read with Para 1.3 and Para 2.1 of the Foreign Trade Policy, 2004-2009, the Central Government hereby makes, with immediate effect, the following amendments to Notification No.32 (RE-2008)/2004-2009, dated 19<sup>th</sup> August, 2008 read with Notification No. 33 (RE-2007)/2004-2009, dated 8<sup>th</sup> October, 2007 as under:

2. (i) The entries relating to Tariff Item HS Code 1006 10 10 against Sl. No. 45A in Notification No.93 (RE-2007)/2004-2009, dated 15.10.2007 would be substituted as under with immediate effect:
