Ukraine sets maximum volume of wheat exports for the 2021/22 season

11/11/2021,

On 19 October 2021, the [Ministry of Agrarian Policy and Food](#) and major grain traders agreed to set the ceiling for wheat exports in the 2021/22 marketing year (July/June) at 25.3 million tonnes, under a policy mechanism that aims to ensure adequate domestic availabilities and preserve food security. If this level of exports were to materialize, it would be a record high and correspond to about 80 percent of the bumper 2021 production estimate.

In the 2020/21 marketing year, the Ministry of Economic Development, Trade and Agriculture had introduced a 17.5 million tonnes quota on wheat exports ([FPMA Food Policy](#)) to guarantee adequate supplies and curb increases of domestic prices of the grain amid the COVID-19 pandemic.

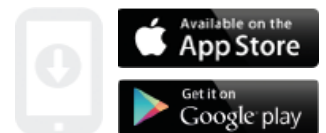
