## **Biodiesel Blend Mandate**

During the months of April through September, diesel fuel sold in the state must be at least B10, increasing to 20% biodiesel (B20) on May 1, 2018. Diesel fuel sold during the remainder of the year must contain at least 5% biodiesel (B5).

The Minnesota Department of Agriculture, Department of Commerce, and the Pollution Control Agency, in consultation with the <u>Biodiesel Task Force (http://www.mda.state.mn.us/renewable/biodiesel/biodiesel/biodieselforce.aspx)</u> and other technical experts, must submit annual reports regarding the implementation of minimum biodiesel content requirements, including information about the price and supply of biodiesel fuel.
