

Biodiesel Blend Mandate

All diesel fuel sold to state agencies, political subdivisions of the state, and public schools for use in on-road motor vehicles must contain at least 5% biodiesel (B5). As of July 1, 2012, all diesel fuel sold to consumers for use in on-road motor vehicles was supposed to contain at least B5. The New Mexico Department of Agriculture and the Energy, Minerals, and Natural Resources Department [suspended](#) these requirements until April 30, 2013, due to biodiesel supply and price differentials.
