^{2.} An increased tax rate applies on gasoline delivered in the jurisdiction of the AMT. This increased tax rate also applies on gasoline that a person brings, or causes to be brought, into the jurisdiction for consumption by such person. In addition, the increased rate applies on gasoline that a person stores or produces in the above-mentioned jurisdiction and on which the tax increase has not been applied. The increased rate does not, however, apply on gasoline to be used for supplying an aircraft engine or on gasoline brought into the jurisdiction in a fuel tank installed as standard equipment to supply the engine of a motor vehicle or a vessel.

^{3.} The designated region is bounded on the west by the border region located in the electoral division of Chapleau; on the north, within 20 kilometres of Route 148; on the east, by the border region located in the electoral division of Argenteuil; and on the south, by the Rivière des Outaouais (Ottawa River).
