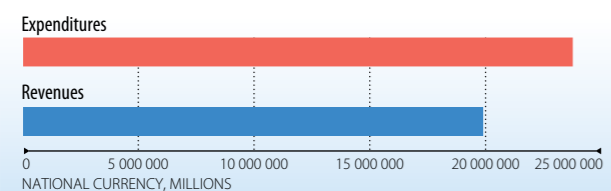

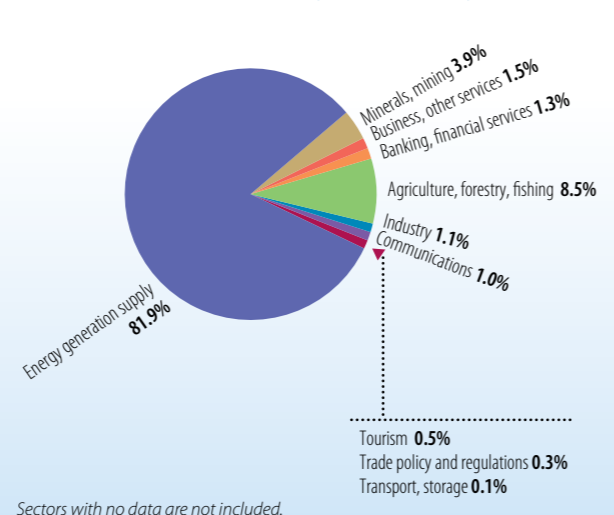

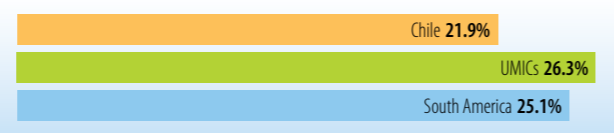

### BY SECTOR (Share in total AFT, commitments, 2009)




### SHARE IN ODA (Commitments, 2008-09 avg.)

AFT share in sector allocable ODA compared to its region and income group shares



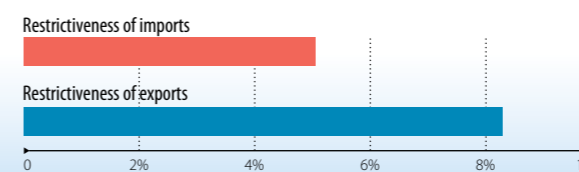

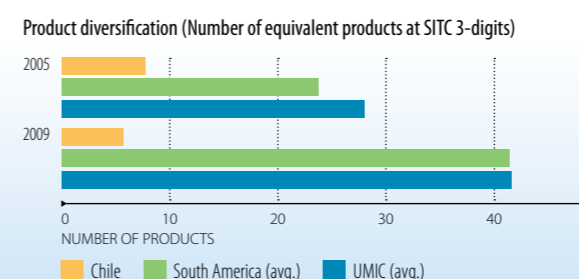
Aid-for-trade priorities remain unchanged. Trade is fully mainstreamed in the national development plan.

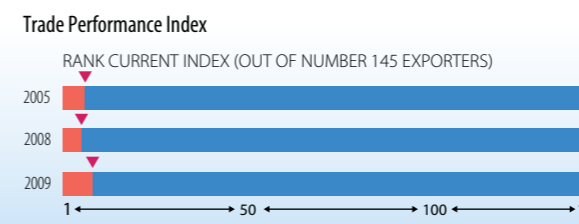

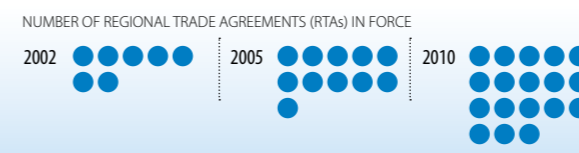
#### PRIORITY 1: EXPORT DIVERSIFICATION<sup>16</sup>

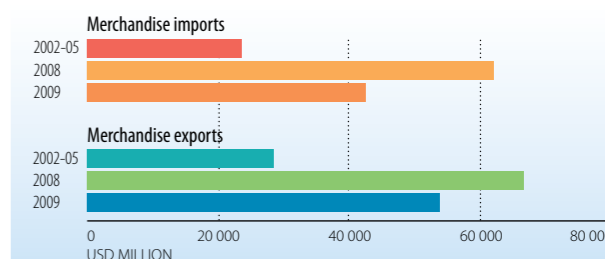

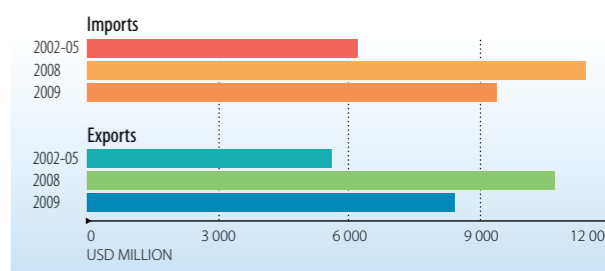

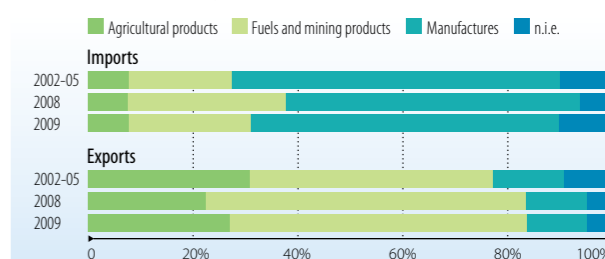
