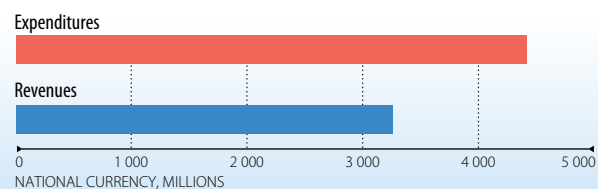

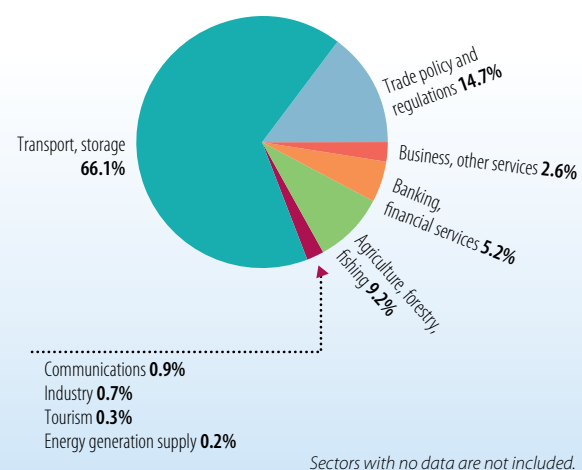

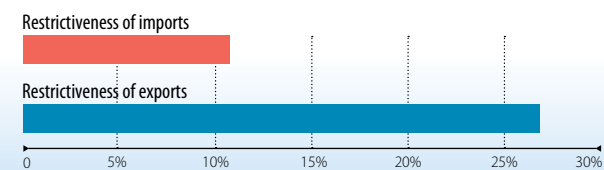

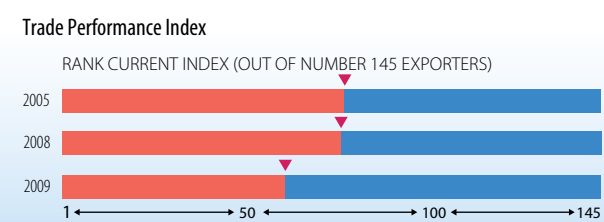
Changes to aid-for-trade priorities have been mainstreamed in the national development plan and operational strategies have been updated accordingly.

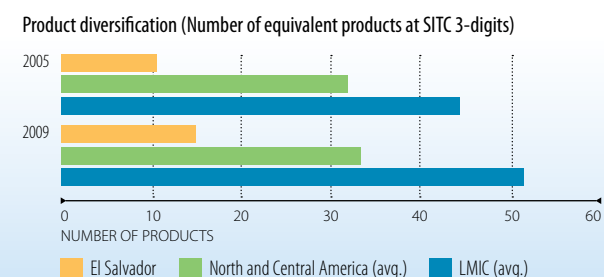

PRIORITY 2: EXPORT DIVERSIFICATION¹⁷



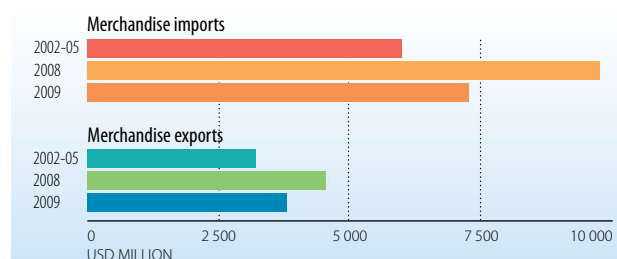

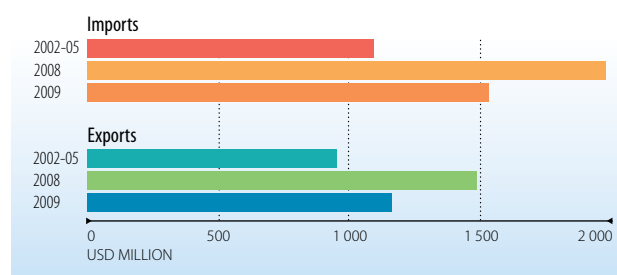

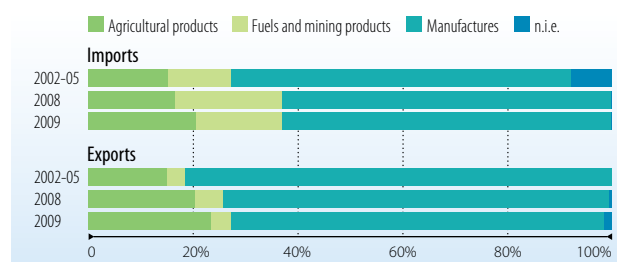
