

SHARE OF AFT IN DEVELOPMENT FINANCE AND FIXED CAPITAL FORMATION (%)



AFT DISBURSEMENTS BY SECTOR (million current USD)










GLOBAL COMPETITIVENESS INDICATORS (1-7)




TRADE COSTS (ad-valorem, %)




